Integrity – the formation of an organizational culture in which ethical norms and standards of behavior are observed, including the implementation of ethical norms and values, decision-making in compliance with the norms of ethics and integrity, as well as being a model of ethical behavior for subordinates, showing impartiality, justice, selflessness, as well as respect for the honor and dignity of the individual.
